THE BRIDGE PROGRAM, SESSIONS ONE & TWO:

Our Bridge Program is a program that enhances children's academic experience by preparing them to begin school in September. **In each course, your child will review skills learned in the 2016-2017 school year. Your child will also be provided with an academic bridge to the skill set taught in the upcoming 2017-2018 school year.**

Targeting the struggling or reluctant learner and the beginning ELL student, this program focuses on the academic skill set particular to the grade-specific Mathematics and English Language Arts curriculum. We provide our students with the encouragement, knowledge, strategies, and practice to help them transition to the next grade level with confidence.

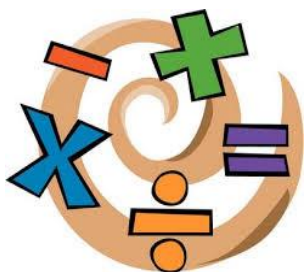
You may register your child for Session One **and/or** Session Two. Each session provides two weeks of morning classes. Session One is July 17-July 28 and Session Two is from July 31-August 11. Each three-hour class, from 8:30 am- 11:30 am is split between English Language Arts and Mathematics, providing 7.5 hours of Math instruction and 7.5 hours of ELA instruction each week.

Our Summer Enrichment Program provides all children with a camp experience that encourages them to practice and apply their skills in creative, new ways. To take an afternoon course, your child does not have to be enrolled in the morning Bridge Program.**

Session One, July 17th - July 28th :

Little Yogi, Grades 1-3 (July 17th-July 21st)

STANDARD FEES:

The cost of a Bridge program/session is \$550.00 (two weeks/30-hours of instruction/per session).

The cost of each enrichment course is \$275/15- hours/one week, plus an all-inclusive materials fee. Full payment is due with registration. Participants will be notified when courses are cancelled. There will be no refunds for voluntary withdrawal of a child after June 1, 2017. In the event that a child withdraws prior to June 1, 2017, any refund will be subject to an administrative charge of \$50.00 per child/per course. The fee will not be refunded if registrant simply does not attend or withdraws from the course after the first day of the course. A full refund will only be provided, including the materials fee, if the course does not have the required enrollment to run.

Parents are responsible for transportation to and from camp. Drop-off is at 8:15 AM and 11:45. Pick-up is at 11:30 and at 3:00 PM at the Eastchester Middle School front entrance.
